

# A Spa on Central Park



The renovation of this 7,500-square-foot apartment located in Manhattan sheds light on its owner's philosophy of life: it includes a generously sized bathroom, which is flooded with natural light, and enjoys breathtaking views out over Central Park. It was designed to permit meditation as well as to allow one to enjoy a relaxing bath. The entire house is thus impregnated with this spirit: the floor in the master bedroom resembles tatami mats, and a special floor was installed in another room to allow one to practice yoga. Shades of ivory and teak lend a serene, minimalist air, and the small Asian-inspired details define a décor that eschews excess. The area of the spa is connected to the master bedroom and to one of the terraces that extend around the apartment. This generates the privacy and independence that one needs to be able to rest, reflect, and recover one's internal equilibrium and peace.
